

Week 8 Gear Roundup

You don't need 500 pet gadgets. You need the right tools - the ones that save your sanity and train your dog at the same time.

For Travel & Safety

[] Car Seatbelt Buckle Adapter - Secures your puppy in the backseat using their collar or martingale.

Why? It keeps them from becoming a flying fur missile during a brake check.

[] Hands-Free Leash (Adjustable) - Worn around your waist. Keeps your pup one foot from your side for tether training.

Why? It reinforces calm following and leash respect with every step.

[] Corkscrew Ground Anchor + Long Lead (15 to 30 ft) - Gives your puppy yard time even without a fence.

Why? It provides space to explore but still forces proximity to you which builds trust and focus.

For Feeding & Gut Health

[] Slow Feeder Bowl - Slows them down during mealtime to prevent gulping, gas, and bloating.

Why? It teaches patience and improves digestion. No more scarf-and-barf.

[] NuVet Supplement (Referral Code: 25043) - Immune support that bridges the transition off moms milk.

Why? Its a daily treat that supports their skin, coat, gut, and resilience without the gimmicks.

For Structure & Routine

[] Amazon Crate with Divider and Single Pull Latch - Adjusts as your puppy grows and locks securely in one smooth pull.

Why? It creates a den they feel safe in. Too much space too soon equals crate accidents. Dont skip the divider.

[] Expandable Puppy Gates - Used to block off rooms or create a small, safe play area.

Why? It teaches boundaries early and keeps them from free-roaming the house before they've earned it.

For Stimulation & Focus

[] Puzzle Toys and Kongs - Fill them with frozen food, peanut butter, or kibble paste.

Why? They challenge the brain and keep busy mouths from chewing furniture.

[] Suction Cup Tether - Useful during brushing, baths, or training sessions.

Why? It helps your puppy practice calm restraint without leash frustration.

[] Training Treats and Clicker (optional) - Soft, small treats work best for quick reinforcement.

Why? Rewards are your puppy's currency. Spend them with purpose.

One Last Thing

[] Final Note - Every item here has been tested in real-world chaos. Not picked for aesthetics.

Picked because they work. They help create calm behavior, safer play, and better connection.

The point isn't just to buy things. It's to use them with intention.
